

# How to apply your Scubacool cylinder cover

What will you need?



Your design & protective sleeve

Hairdryer

Scissors

Cleaning cloth & towel

Remove your boot (if you have one) &  
clean your cylinder

Place your design on your cylinder & ensure that the top of the design is inline with the shoulder of your cylinder

Now place the protective sleeve over your cylinder & design

Stand your cylinder up on a table or the floor.

Ensure that the sleeve extends at least 2 inches past the base of the cylinder





Trim the plastic sleeve  
roughly 2 inches above the  
shoulder of your cylinder

Now the plastic sleeve should fit your cylinder perfectly with roughly 2 inches above the shoulder and below the base.



Using a hairdryer, begin to shrink the plastic sleeve.

Move slowly from the centre of the cylinder, up & down.

Ensure that you properly shrink the plastic around the shoulder of the cylinder





And around the base

Once the plastic is smooth and uniformly shrunk, replace your boot & you are ready to dive!
